## Fruit Trees - Malus, Prunus, Pyrus

Apples, Applecrabs, Pears and Plums, require cross pollination for good fruit production. Usually any two or three cultivars will give sufficient overlap in flowering periods for effective pollination. Dwarf varieties are half the size of regular varieties. Average height of fruit trees are shown below.


